



IVSC Website Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how Itchen Valley Shooting Club, which is one of the “Winchester Combined Clubs” that together hold the lease for the Winchester tunnel range, uses and protects any information that you give to Itchen Valley Shooting Club when you use this website.

Itchen Valley Shooting Club is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

Itchen Valley Shooting Club may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from 25 May 2018.

We may collect the following information

title, name(s), photograph, address(es), date of birth, telephone number(s), email address(es), club/organisation affiliation details, FAC number and expiry date (if applicable), FAC revocation, club or association names, RCO / Instructor / Coaching qualification details, certification details, medical and medication issues, attendance and shooting records, competition entry and results, renewal tracking including payment details, bank account details.

What we do with the information we gather

Itchen Valley Shooting Club requires this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- The administration of:
 - Management and Membership of IVSC, including membership waiting list Winchester Combined Clubs
 - Affiliation of the IVSC and its members to external organisations
 - Insurances
 - Internal and external range booking management
 - Internal and external competition management (examples include insurance, selection, reporting)
- Liaison with external law enforcement and Firearms Licencing bodies (examples include membership, screening and approval information, shooting history information)
- Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC) registration recording and reporting requirements, including related liaison with HMRC
- Financial records
- Attendance
- Shooting records
- Training, Qualifications and Certifications
- Events
- Armoury and other purchases
- Reimbursing expenses incurred on the clubs behalf
- Internal and external notification and publishing of results either for an individual event or combined with other events (examples include name, club affiliation, scores, age category)
- External funding applications (examples include grant applications)
- Internal club communication (examples include email, text, phone call)
- Anonymised trend reporting



Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
